# Submission Guidelines

Follow these steps to participate in Arts Etobicoke's Student Art Show:

## 1. CHOOSE ARTWORK

- Limit of one original artwork per youth and a maximum of 8 entries per school/agency.
- We are open to artwork in all 2-d and 3-d media including but not limited to: drawing, painting, printmaking, comics, sculpture, photography/digital media, and mixed media. If you've got something fabulous that doesn't match this criteria, please contact us and we will do our best to accommodate you.

## 2. REGISTER YOUR STUDENTS ON-LINE

## 3. PREPARE SUBMISSIONS FOR DISPLAY

### PLEASE DO!

- Submit work that's ready to hang.
- Ensure that each 2-d piece has rings or screw eyes attached on both sides at the back of the work.
- Hang wire no more than 6 " from the top of the frame, please use an appropriate gauge single strand wire. Wire substitutes will not be accepted.

### PLEASE DON'T!

- Deliver wet or poorly wired artwork, or faulty frames or canvasses.
- Send work in glass clip frames as they are too fragile and may break and damage artwork.
- Add to or substitute entries. The proposed work must be the work that arrives for display!

## 4. DELIVER ARTWORK

- **MONDAY FEBRUARY 27, 2017 3:30PM-5:00PM ONLY.**
- No submissions will be accepted at any other times.
- Please bring artwork to 180 Shaw Street, Studio 207- 2nd floor (3 Delta Studio). Look for the sign in the lobby.
- Drop off parking: free/short term parking available in the driveway on Argyle Street, North end of the building.
